From welcoming its first cohort of 40 residential students in 1948, the college now educates around 4,000 students and 800 apprentices a year at sites across Northern England.




Digital and **Technological** Integration

This facility includes a calf rearing area, a beef grower unit, and a special space for teaching and learning, equipped with state-of-the-art equipment that will be integrated into our courses.

Our goal is to focus on sustainable and ethical farming methods. In the precision livestock facility, students get to work with cuttingedge technology. They use real-time data to make important decisions about animal husbandry and welfare. It's a hands-on experience that prepares students for the real world.

In addition to our focus on agriculture and farming, we're also committed to preparing students using digital technology. Our Digital Skills Academy is dedicated to giving students the skills they need to succeed in this fast-paced field. For example, students get to use virtual reality headsets, augmented reality tools, and lidar scanning for environmental management applications.

By combining modern farming techniques and digital skills training, we are helping students become well-rounded and ready for the challenges of tomorrow's industries.

Timeline of Progression

We offer a range of programme levels, with full-time and part-time options, allowing you to choose the perfect route for your lifestyle and goals.

Level 3

Foundation Year (Level 3 equivalent)

These programmes are designed for people aged 18 or over who want to return to education and prepare students to study at degree-level.

Level 5

Foundation Degrees

These two-year degree programmes allow graduates to progress onto further study to achieve a BA or BSc degree. They are flexible, technical and employment related degrees that incorporate work-based study.



Level 6

Bachelor's Degrees

A traditional three-year degree programme. Here at UCAB, we offer these as Bachelor of Science (BSc). Where you see (Hons) you will graduate with honours, provided you meet the required academic standard needed.

Bachelor's Top Up

These programmes allow you to top up your Level 5 qualification to achieve a full bachelor's degree in one year full-time or two years part-time. You may wish to continue in the same subject or, in some cases, you can switch to another subject.

Level 7

Master's Degrees

These postgraduate courses are the highest level of study that we offer. To be eligible to study a master's degree, students must have already completed a BSc.
