- From **15th April 2024** the online bursary platform will be open for student applications for the academic year 2024-25.
- **Residential Grant** – The deadline for students wishing to reside in accommodation is **31st July 2024**. We cannot guarantee that applications received after this date will be processed in time for the September start.
- **Discretionary Bursaries** – the deadline for applications is the end of September 2024. We cannot guarantee that applications received after this date will be assessed until after October half term.
- **Childcare Funding** – To apply for financial assistance towards your childcare costs please contact Student Services on 01904 772277 or via the email: Bursaries@Askham-bryan.ac.uk they will be able to advise you about the support available.
- Applications will continue to be assessed throughout the academic year until all of the funds are distributed.

Applications need to be completed online via the link on the website or via the paper application if preferred. To apply you must have a valid student ID number and your supporting evidence ready to upload. Your application will be acknowledged via email once it is submitted.
