Middlesbrough

Situated in the beautiful World Heritage site of Saltaire and surrounded by Robert's Park. It's a great place to study and easy to get to by bus or train from most areas of West Yorkshire (the Centre is directly next to the train station for easy access).

Transport

We provide transport for students enrolled on our courses, partnering with local coach companies to offer reliable service to and from our York and Middlesbrough campuses, operating from designated points across Yorkshire. Our college buses run Monday to Friday during term time only.

All buses drop off and pick up at the campuses, returning along the same routes as the inbound journey. We regularly review existing routes and develop new ones throughout the year.

To keep travel costs low, we subsidise most of the transport expenses, ensuring a cost-effective, safe, and comfortable travel option to our campuses.

For York campus travellers, costs vary by distance from the pick-up point. There is a flat fee for using transport to our Stewart Park, Middlesbrough location.

If you are applying to study at our centres located at Gateshead, Saltaire and Wakefield, although we don't offer transport directly, if you contact the individual study centre, they will be more than happy to answer your questions on the options available.

Course types overview

Progression of study programmes

Entry Level Courses:

Part of our Foundation Learning department these courses are for learners with no formal qualifications who want to progress in life and work in a vocational area. We welcome applications from students who need more support or have learning difficulties or disabilities and/or an Educational Health Care Plan (EHCP).

Level 1 Study Programmes:

Part of our Foundation Learning department these courses provide a step up from basic knowledge, providing a supportive environment in which to learn skills specific to a particular work sector. These courses prepare students for more specialised study or entry-level employment.

Level 2 Study Programmes:

Equivalent to GCSE Grades 4-9 (A-C), these programmes further develop sector specific knowledge and skills. They include a mix of technical and non-technical qualifications and are often the first stage where practical applications are more significant.

Level 3 Study Programmes:

Equivalent to A-levels, these programmes offer in-depth knowledge, skills, and understanding necessary for professional work or Higher Education. T-Levels are a Level 3 programme.





T-Levels explained

T Levels are a two-year qualification equivalent to 3 A-Levels, other post-16 courses, or apprenticeships. These courses integrate classroom learning with extended industry placements to provide a blend of theoretical knowledge and practical experience tailored to the needs of businesses and employers.

T Level structure

80% college learning:

Covers core theories, principles, and subject-specific knowledge relevant to the chosen work sector. Around a third of your time will be practical, hands-on learning.

20% industry placement (45 days):

Provides hands-on, practical experience with an employer to develop real-world skills and understanding.

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are work-based programmes that combine on-the-job training with formal study. Apprentices spend at least 20% of their time in training, either through day release or block release at a college. This format offers an alternative for those who prefer a more employment-focused path.



Agriculture

These courses are ideal for anyone passionate about farming and interested in livestock, crop production, or farm engineering. You will explore Agri-Tech developments, environmental impacts on farming, and advancements in farming techniques.

We have heavily invested in our farm resources, offering students the chance to apply theory to practice and gain valuable experience in livestock management, including dairy, beef, and sheep enterprises. Our arable and grassland operations provide hands-on learning opportunities, while our Agri-tech workshop facilities allow students to develop practical skills in a well-equipped environment.

As a VetSkill accredited centre, Askham Bryan College offers vocational training in veterinary nursing. Graduates are eligible to join the Register of Veterinary Nurses maintained by the Royal College of Veterinary Surgeons.

Foundation Learning

If you have not achieved a Level 4 grade in English and Maths qualifications then you will study for these alongside the programme.

Level 1 courses

The Level 1 Land-Based Programme focuses on practical skills and will also develop your academic skills over the year.

You will attend College for a minimum of 3 days per week and upon completion of your programme you will achieve a Level 1 Diploma in Land-Based Studies

Apprenticeships at Askham Bryan

What is an apprenticeship?

Apprenticeships are work based learning programmes, that require the learner to be employed in a suitable job role. Prior to beginning an apprenticeship, you must be employed in a full-time position, which aligns with the content of your preferred course of study.

On receipt of your application via the website the College will schedule an interview with you and your employer to discuss the next steps.

Apprenticeships frequently asked questions

What are the entry requirements?

You will need to have already achieved a GCSE grade 2 or above, before enrolling to an apprenticeship.

All vacancies are on the government website and will clearly state what the entry requirements are for the job role being advertised. There will be different entry requirements depending on the industry job role and apprenticeship level.

How do I learn?

All apprenticeships include elements of practical learning with your employer and in-classroom training enabling industry-recognised standards, or qualifications.

How am I assessed?

All apprenticeships require an external assessment at the end of your programme which evaluates the apprentice's ability and competence in their job role.

How long is the apprenticeship?

The length of the programme is varied depending on the course chosen.

How much can I earn?

As an apprentice, there will be no cost to you. The National Minimum Wage for apprentices is £6.40 per hour for those aged under 19 or those in the first year of their apprenticeship. Apprentices aged 23 and over and not in the first year of their apprenticeship will be entitled to the full National Minimum Wage.

How many hours will I work?

The minimum duration of each apprenticeship is based on the apprentice working 30 hours a week or more, including any off-the-job training you undertake. The time spent on off-the-job training should be at least 20% and should be included as part of your hours.

Apprentices under the age of 18 are not permitted to work more than 40 hours per week.

Interview Process

Once we have processed your application you will receive a text message with an interview date and time.

The interview will be with a member of the course team and usually by phone.

The interviewer will ask you some questions about why you are interested in the course and any relevant experience or qualifications that you have.

You will also be able to ask any questions that you may have.

Offer of a Place

After the interview you will be emailed with details of the course we have offered you a place on, as well as the exam results you need to achieve in order to secure your place.

If we are unable to offer you a place for any reason we will explain this to you.

We will continue to keep in touch throughout the year via email with further information on what you need to do next.

Results Day and Enrolment

If you don't achieve the exam results you expect on results day, don't panic! Give us a call or an email and we will try and place you on an alternative suitable course.

After results day your place will be confirmed with you and you will receive details on how to enrol ready to start your studies in September.


