Who is harmed and how	Children, school staff, visitors and Museum staff falling on ice or snow, exposed to extreme cold.
Current Controls (Weather)	Staff to monitor conditions and adapt delivery accordingly. Staff to grit and clear pavements if necessary.
Additional Controls (Weather)	staff to follow evacuation procedure if directed. Suitable shoes and clothing to be worn by students. Fires lit and heating on as appropriate.

Current Controls (Slip or Trip Hazard)	Effective briefing and instructions given, emphasising potential risks. Pre organise furniture, rugs and equipment to minimise risks. Monitor. Children are told not to climb on anything. Staff ensure furniture is secure. Monitor children when using the stairs.

Current Controls (Moving Rail Vehicles)	Museum staff in charge of vehicles to be trained accordingly.
Additional Controls (Moving Rail Vehicles)	Museum presenter of activity to brief groups about the possibility of vehicles passing through the area where they will be before they leave the introduction session of the activity. Students supervised by school staff at all times.

Description	Children being bitten, trampled, kicked, stood on, having allergies, illnesses
Who is harmed and how	Children, Beamish staff and teaching staff hurt by livestock (particularly horses)
Current Controls (Animals)	Group informed and anyone with allergy to livestock kept at a safe distance. Handler will manage the horse for the children. Supervising adults to keep children at a safe distance.
Additional Controls (Animals)	Handler manages children so they do not all crowd around. Children wash their hands after seeing the horse and before eating.

Description	Uncontrolled fire / fire spreading
Who is harmed and how	Staff and/or visitors may suffer burns & smoke inhalation
Current Controls (Fire)	<p>Only get out of fire cupboard sufficient flammable materials for activity.</p> <p>Flammable materials are stored at least a metre away from the demonstration area.</p> <p>The trained demonstrator must never leave flammable materials or ignition sources unattended (e.g. even when waiting for a late school group or over lunch - a member of staff must always be present in the room, or the flammables cleared away).</p> <p>Fire blanket must be readily accessible during the demonstration.</p> <p>Demonstration table must be covered in heat-proof mats.</p> <p>Instruct children to put bags underneath their bench so that they can easily exit the pews if needed.</p>
Additional Controls (Fire)	<p>Flammable materials must be stored in fire cabinet located in the Lamp Cabin.</p> <p>Dried out flash cotton to be stored in a separate metal locker on top of the fire cabinet. Only enough flash cotton to do 3 sessions should be dried at a time.</p> <p>Sources of ignition must be kept in a separate box which is located in the locked coal shed behind the chapel.</p>
